CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend 13.351 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to the membership of the state building commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

13.351 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

13.351 (2) (a) There is created a state building commission which shall consist of the governor, who shall be chairman, and 6 members of the legislature of whom 3 shall be from each house, to be appointed as are standing committees in the respective houses, provided that of the members appointed from either house, one shall be a memer of the visiting committee created by section 13.057, and one citizen member to be appointed by the governor who shall serve at the pleasure of the governor as an ex officio member. The terms of all legislative members shall expire on May 1 in each odd-numbered year. The members shall act without liability except for misconduct, and shall receive no compensation for their services but they shall be reimbursed for travel expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties out of the appropriation made in section 20.12 (11).
