CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to create 360.23 of the statutes, relating to stay of execution in justice court.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

360.23 of the statutes is created to read:

360.23 STAY OF EXECUTION. An appellant (or relator on certiorari to a justice) may secure a stay of execution of judgment by giving bail in such sum as the justice or the judge of the appellate court requires, and by complying with section 354.42.
