CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT to amend 270.25 (1) of the statutes, relating to five-sixths verdicts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

270.25 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
270.25 (1) A verdict * * * agreed to by five-sixths of the jurors shall be the verdict * * * of the jury. If more than one question must be answered to arrive at a verdict on the same cause of action, the same five-sixths of the jurors must agree on all $such\ questions.$
