CHAPTER 360.

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 185.15 of the statutes, relating to quorum at membership meetings of co-operatives.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

185.15 of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

185.15 QUORUM. The number of members necessary to constitute a quorum at a meeting of the members of an association organized under this chapter shall be as follows:

(1) In associations having a total membership of under 500, 10 per cent or twice the number of the board of directors, whichever is greater;

(2) In associations having a total membership in excess of 500, 50 members;

(3) At any regular or special meeting legally called, a number of members not less than twice the number of the board of directors may constitute a quorum to transact any business, other than amending articles of incorporation, which has been specifically set forth in the notice of the meeting, including business transacted pursuant to section 180.25. The quorum shall be present in person or represented by territorial delegates in accordance with section 185.10.
