CHAPTER 378.

AN ACT to amend 85.01 (4) (fm) of the statutes, relating to the registration fee of motor vehicles operated for special uses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.01 (4) (fm) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.01 (4) (fm) Any motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer, if operated empty, or transporting the equipment of the owner to or from a certain location over the public highways, when such operation at the location is the performance of work on a contract for the construction or maintenance of highways or airports for the United States, state or any political subdivision thereof; or the production of agricultural lime; or clearing land, dike building, terracing and ditching for the purpose of soil erosion control or farm drainage, or mobile cranes * * * used for bridges and building construction, heavy machinery installation and loading of heavy articles, shall be registered under this section by the motor vehicle department for a flat annual fee of \$10. The motor vehicle department shall issue a distinguishing license plate for each such vehicle.
