## CHAPTER 463.

AN ACT to amend 348.01 of the statutes, relating to lotteries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

348.01 of the statutes is amended to read:

348.01 Any person who shall set up or promote any lottery for money, or shall dispose of any property of value, real or personal, by way of a lottery, or who shall aid, either by printing or writing, or shall in any way be concerned in setting up, managing or drawing any such lottery, or who shall, in any house, shop or building owned or occupied by him or under his control, knowingly permit the setting up, managing or drawing of any such lottery, or the sale of any lottery ticket, share of a ticket, or any other writing, certificate, bill, token or any other device purporting or intended to entitle the holder, bearer or any other person to any prize or interest or share of any prize to be drawn in a lottery shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not more than 6 months or by fine not exceeding \$100. In order for a radio or television show or program to be held in violation of this section it shall be necessary to show that consideration involves either the payment of money, or requires an expenditure of substantial effort or time. Mere technical contract consideration shall not be sufficient. Listening to a radio, or listening to and watching a television show shall not be deemed consideration given or received.
