## CHAPTER 533.

AN ACT to create 46.047 of the statutes, relating to the purchase of lands by the department of public welfare for a medium security prison and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

46.047 of the statutes is created to read:

46.047 PURCHASE OF LANDS FOR MEDIUM SECURITY PRISON. The state department of public welfare, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to purchase approximately 150 acres of farm lands adjoining the south boundary of the present property line of the central state hospital or other suitable buildings and lands near the Wisconsin state prison, such lands to be used for the establishment and development (including the construction of buildings) of a medium security prison to be a part of the Wisconsin state prison. The money to be expended for the purchase of such farm lands shall be charged to the revolving appropriation in section 20.17 (11) of the statutes.
