CHAPTER 591.

AN ACT to amend 85.45 (2) (a) of the statutes, relating to size of trucks.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.45 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.45 (2) (a) No vehicle including any load thereon shall exceed a total outside width of 8 feet, except that the width of a farm tractor shall not exceed 9 feet and that the limitations as to the size of vehicle stated in this section shall not apply to implements of husbandry temporarily propelled or moved upon the highway or to those vehicles operating under special permits issued in accordance with section 85.53; and except further that such total width of motor trucks operated prior to July 1, 1929, on solid tires shall not exceed 8 feet 6 inches when equipped with dual pneumatic tires; and except further that the total width of urban passenger busses, busses operated as auxiliary to or as a part of a street railway system in counties of 500,000 population or more and trackless trollies shall not exceed 8 feet 8 inches, and the total width of load of pulp wood or slabs and unplaned dimension material cut therefrom shall not exceed 8 feet 4 inches.
