## CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT to create 66.195 of the statutes, relating to adjustments in salaries of local officers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.195 of the statutes is created to read:

66.195 EMERGENCY SALARY ADJUSTMENTS. For the period commencing with the effective date of this act and ending December 31, 1953, the governing body of any county, city, village or town may, during the term of office of any elected official whose salary is paid in whole or in part by such county, city, village or town increase the salary of such elected official in such amount as the governing body may determine. The power granted by this section shall take effect notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, except that the exercise of such power shall be governed by the provisions of section 65.90 (5).
