CHAPTER 622.

AN ACT to create 100.20 (4) of the statutes, relating to complaints to the department of agriculture by the attorney-general regarding unfair trade practices.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

100.20 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

100.20 (4) The attorney-general may file a written complaint with the department alleging that the person named therein is employing unfair methods of competition in business or unfair trade practices in business or both. Whenever such a complaint is filed it shall be the duty of the department to proceed, after proper notice and in accordance with its rules, to the hearing and adjudication of the matters therein alleged, and the attorney-general may appear before the department in such proceedings. He shall be entitled to judicial review of the decisions and orders of the department as provided in chapter 227.
