CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT to amend 36.06 (4) of the statutes, relating to use of men's and women's dormitories at the university of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

36.06 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

36.06 (4) In the use of men's and women's dormitories at the university, preference as to rooming and boarding facilities shall be given to students who are legal residents of this state; * * * excepting that the board of regents may set aside a small quota of accommodations, not to exceed 6 per cent, for assignment to students who are residents of other states or are from countries and territories outside the continental limits of the United States. In case additional facilities remain after such preference, the above mentioned rooming and boarding facilities may be extended to additional nonresident students. The board shall make suitable rules and regulations for carrying such dormitory preferences into effect. All salaries and compensations provided for in this section shall be charged against the proper appropriation for the board of regents of the university.
