CHAPTER 76.

AN ACT to create 71.11 (49) of the statutes, relating to assistance by the attorney-general in prosecuting income tax fraud cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

71.11 (49) of the statutes is created to read:

71.11 (49) PROSECUTIONS BY ATTORNEY-GENERAL. The attorney-general is authorized, upon the request of the commissioner of taxation, to represent the state or to assist the district attorney in the prosecution of any case arising under subsections (41), (42) and (43).
