CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to amend 59.07 (13) of the statutes, relating to enabling counties to appropriate money to school districts in lieu of taxes on public lands.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.07 (13) of the statutes is amended to read: 59.07 (13) Appropriate to any school district in which a county farm or a state charitable or penal institution or any state-owned lands which are used for agricultural purposes or any part thereof is situated, an amount of money for school purposes equal to the amount that would be paid as school taxes upon such farm land or part thereof situated within such district if such land were privately owned. The valuation of such farm land shall be determined by the county board * * *.
