CHAPTER 166

AN ACT to amend 222.06 of the statutes, relating to election of assistant treasurers and assistant secretaries of savings banks.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

222.06 of the statutes is amended to read:

222.06 The trustees or directors, within 10 days after their election, shall elect from the members of their own board, a president, one or more vice presidents, a treasurer, a secretary and a finance or executive committee, and may also elect one or more persons as assistant treasurers and assistant secretaries *who need not be trustees or directors*; provided that the same person may act as treasurer and secretary or as assistant treasurer and assistant secretary. The trustees may also appoint such other officers and employes as they shall deem necessary. All said officers shall hold their offices until others are elected and qualified to fill their places.
