CHAPTER 194

AN ACT to amend 69.41 of the statutes, relating to filing of additional report in the case of the death of a person in military service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

69.41 of the statutes is amended to read:

69.41 Any coroner who holds an inquest on the body of any deceased person required for a burial permit, shall state in his certificate the nature of the disease, or the manner of death, and if from external causes or violence whether "probably" accidental, suicidal or homicidal, as determined by the inquest; and shall furnish such information as may be required by the state registrar to classify the death. Where the cause of death of a member of the armed forces of the United States is also investigated by competent military authority, the certified statement thereof as to cause of death may be filed with the register of deeds who shall attach such statement to the coroner's certificate.
