## CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT to amend 41.03 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to instruction of handicapped children by itinerant teachers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.03 (1) (d) of the statutes is amended to read: 41.03 (1) (d) Out of the appropriations for crippled children, there shall be paid in full a sum sufficient to cover the full cost of salary and travel expenses in amounts agreed upon in advance by the state superintendent to the district conducting an orthopedic school for the services rendered by the physical therapists outside the employing district \* \* \*. Out of appropriations made for the instruction of children, defective of speech, hearing or vision and of children who are mentally retarded a sum sufficient to cover the full cost of salary and travel expenses made necessary for providing instruction to children outside the district of employment in amounts agreed upon in advance by the state superintendent.
