## CHAPTER 348

- AN ACT to create 85.831 of the statutes, relating to stipulation of guilt for violation of certain provisions of chapter 85 of the statutes or local ordinances adopted in conformity therewith.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.831 of the statutes is created to read:

85.831 RIGHT TO STIPULATE GUILT; PROCEDURE. Local ordinances adopted in conformity with the provisions of this chapter, may contain a provision for stipulation of guilt of the offense charged as to such offenses and in such manner as the local ordinance shall designate. When such stipulation is timely and payment of the penalty fixed is made to the designated official, the person charged with the offense need not appear in court and no witness fees or other additional costs shall be taxed unless the local ordinance . so provides.
