CHAPTER 374

AN ACT to create 66.061 (1) (d) of the statutes, relating to public utility franchises in cities or villages.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.061 (1) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

66.061 (1) (d) Whenever any city or village at the time of its incorporation included within its corporate limits territory in which a public utility, prior to such incorporation, had been lawfully engaged in rendering public utility service, such public utility shall be deemed to possess a franchise to operate in such city or village to the same extent as though such franchise had been formally granted by ordinance duly adopted by the governing body of such city or village. This paragraph shall not apply to any public utility organized under any provision of ch. 66.
