## CHAPTER 447

AN ACT to create 348.092 (4) and (5) of the statutes, relating to declaring gambling places public nuisances and providing penalties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

348.092 (4) and (5) of the statutes are created to read:

348.092 (4) Gambling in any manner or by any means which is prohibited by this chapter is unlawful, and constitutes a public nuisance, and any house, place, building, premises in or upon which gambling is carried on and which is found to be a common gambling house, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and subject to be abated as provided in s. 348.085 (3).

(5) Whenever it shall be made to appear to any court having jurisdiction to abate a public nuisance that 2 or more offenses of keeping a gambling house have been committed in any house, place, building or premises, said house, place, building or premises is hereby declared to be a public nuisance and subject to be enjoined and abated in the manner provided by ss. 280.09 to 280.15 which shall apply to such nuisance and actions to abate and perpetually enjoin the same.
