CHAPTER 507

AN ACT to amend 40.12 (1) of the statutes, as renumbered and amended by chapter 90, laws of 1953, relating to the composition of territory in a union high school district.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

40.12 (1) of the statutes, as renumbered and amended by chapter 90, laws of 1953, is amended to read:

40.12 (1) A union high school district may be established in any * * territory with an assessed valuation of \$1,250,000 or more. A high school district may also be established in any township comprising only island territory. At the time of filing the petition mentioned in subs. (2) and (3), the petitioners shall submit to the state superintendent a legal description and map of the territory proposed to be included in the district. No election on the establishment of such district shall be held unless the state superintendent has approved such territory. A copy of such description and map, with the approval of the state superintendent indorsed thereon, shall be submitted to the clerk of each governmental subdivision affected by the establishment of such district.
