CHAPTER 552

AN ACT to create 192.268 of the statutes, relating to windshield and canopy on track motor car.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

192.268 of the statutes is created to read: 192.268 WINDSHIELD AND CANOPY ON TRACK MOTOR CARS. It shall be unlawful after July 1, 1955 for any person, firm or corporation operating or controlling

any railroad running through or within the state to operate or use in motion any track motor car, without a canopy or top, and a windshield and windshield wiper to adequately protect the occupants thereof from the weather, except that this section shall not apply to track motor cars which operate within the confines of the railroad yards.
