CHAPTER 567

AN ACT to create 235.015 of the statutes, relating to conveyances by a married minor woman.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

235.015 of the statutes is created to read:

235.015 CONVEYANCES BY A MARRIED MINOR WOMAN. A married minor woman by joining with her adult husband in an instrument of conveyance in substantially the form prescribed in ss. 235.06, 235.07 or 235.08 executed and acknowledged in the manner prescribed by this chapter for conveying real estate by adults may alienate any right, title or interest she may have in any real estate, including her inchoate right of dower. A conveyance so made by a married minor woman shall as effectively convey and divest her of right, title or interest in the real estate therein described, and the covenants contained therein shall be as binding upon her, as if she were an adult at the time of the execution thereof. This section shall supersede any provision of law in conflict herewith.
