## **CHAPTER 607**

AN ACT to amend 226.09 of the statutes, relating to proceedings to oust a foreign corporation from the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

226.09 of the statutes is amended to read:

226.09 Upon complaint and evidence which shall satisfy the attorney-general that any foreign corporation has violated s. 226.07, he shall forthwith bring an action in the name of the state in any circuit court to have the license of such corporation to do business in this state annulled and to oust it from this state. The provisions of \* \* \* \* ss. 133.22, 133.23 and 133.24 shall extend to all proceedings under this section.
