The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

14.75 (4) (introductory paragraph) of the statutes is amended to read: 14.75 (4) (introductory paragraph) * * * A committee of 2, one an Indian shall be appointed by the governor for such term as may be fixed by him, to represent the state on the governors' interstate Indian council. * * * The members of the committee shall serve without compensation, except that they shall be paid their actual and necessary expenses from the * * * appropriation made by s. 20.67, on vouchers approved by the governor.
