## **CHAPTER 637**

AN ACT to amend 29.10 of the statutes (as amended by chapter 319, laws of 1953), relating to resident small game hunting licenses and adjustment of damages arising on public hunting and fishing grounds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.10 of the statutes (as amended by chapter 319, laws of 1953) is amended to read: 29.10 Resident small game hunting licenses shall be issued subject to s. 29.09, by designated permanent civil service employes of the commission and by the county clerks upon blanks supplied to them by the commission, to residents duly applying therefor who have resided in this state for at least one year next preceding the application. The fee for each license is \$2. Such license does not permit the hunting of deer. The com-

mission shall spend for the acquisition, leasing, development and maintenance of public hunting and fishing grounds, and the adjustment and payment of damages arising from the operation of the same, not less than one-fourth of the net cash receipts derived from the sale of resident small game hunting licenses.
