CHAPTER 676

AN ACT to amend 176.05 (6a) of the statutes, relating to the serving of free cheese in "Class B" establishments.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

176.05 (6a) of the statutes is amended to read: 176.05 (6a) The rules and regulations made by the state board of health governing sanitation in restaurants shall apply to all "Class B" licenses issued under this section provided that the board shall not restrict the serving of free cheese in individual portions to patrons as permitted by ss. 160.01 (2) and 176.50. No "Class B" license shall be issued unless the premises to be licensed conform to such rules and regulations.
