**CHAPTER 94.**

AN ACT to amend 15.60 (6) of the statutes, relating to the authority of the director of purchases to make certain purchases without regard to the low bid requirements.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

15.60 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

15.60 (6) \* \* \* The provisions of subs. (1) to (5), except as to their requirements in connection with printing and stationery, shall not be deemed to apply, *prior to July 1, 1955*, to the purchase of supplies, materials or equipment from the federal government or any agency thereof and, with the approval of the governor, may be waived with respect to similar purchases from private sources when such action is deemed to be in the best interests of the state.
