CHAPTER 156

AN ACT to amend 316.41 of the statutes, relating to the purchase of property by the executor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

316.41 of the statutes is amended to read:

316.41 The executor, administrator or guardian making the sale or the guardian of any heir of the decedent shall not be interested in the purchase of any part of the real estate sold unless such sale is made with written consent of the parties concerned and of the guardian ad litem for minors and incompetents and approval of the court after notice and hearing * * * , except where such purchase is authorized by the will of the decedent. This section shall not prohibit such purchase by a guardian for the benefit of his ward.
