CHAPTER 193

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 41.01 (2a) of the statutes, relating to preschool and adult instruction or treatment of the handicapped.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.01 (2a) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

41.01 (2a) Any school district which operates a class for handicapped children may provide instruction or treatment for preschool handicapped children and instruction for their parents. The Wisconsin school for the deaf may provide instruction for preschool deaf children and their parents. The Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped may provide instruction for preschool visually handicapped children and their parents. The conducting of such instruction or treatment shall be subject to approval of and shall comply with requirements established by the state superintendent.
