CHAPTER 200

AN ACT to create 60.18 (11) of the statutes, relating to compensation of constables.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 60.18 (11) of the statutes is created to read:

60.18 (11) COMPENSATION OF CONSTABLE. To set the total annual compensation of the town constable in lieu of all fees and mileage or any portion of such fees and mileage. The compensation established shall not be increased nor diminished during the officer's term and shall remain the same unless changed by further action of an annual town meeting. Any constable on a salary basis or part fees and part salary shall collect all fees appertaining to his office and file with the town clerk a complete record of all fees received, annually or at such times as the town board may require, and shall remit all such fees not specifically reserved to him to the town treasurer at least once each month.
