## CHAPTER 207

AN ACT to renumber 80.07; and to create 80.07 (2) and 83.01 (7) (g) of the statutes, relating to the county highway commissioner, a county highway register and collection and preservation of highway records.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 80.07 of the statutes is renumbered 80.07 (1).

SECTION 2. 80.01 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

80.07 (2) Whenever the supervisors lay out, alter or discontinue any highway the town clerk shall transmit a certified copy of the order therefor to the county highway commissioner.

SECTION 3. 83.01 (7) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

83.01 (7) (g) He shall compile and maintain a record of the laying out, alteration or discontinuance of all highways in the county outside the limits of cities and villages. The record shall be known as the county highway register and be kept in the manner or form prescribed by the state highway commission. The county highway commissioner or his agents shall have access to the records of town clerks and may have temporary custody of such as are necessary for the purpose of making accurate and appropriate copies thereof. The state highway commission shall assist in the compilation of the records and shall furnish to the county highway commissioner such information as the commission deems appropriate relative to the laying out of military, territorial and such other roads as have been authorized by the legislature. The information contained in the county highway register shall be admissible in evidence.
