## CHAPTER 268

AN ACT to amend 84.105 (2) of the statutes, relating to national parkways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

84.105 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

84.105 (2) For the purposes of this section, all terms applying to any parkway, such as "secretary", "parkway", "scenic landscape", "sightly or safety easement", "access", "parkway road", "parkway development", "national parkway", "frontage", and other or similar terms, which are defined in any act of the United States congress applicable to such national parkway, shall have the meanings set forth in such act. The term "national parkway" as used in this section shall mean and include the Great River Road and appurtenances thereto, as provided in section 14 of P. L. 350, 83rd congress, chapter 181, 2nd session, or any other parkway or road in Wisconsin projected in general accordance with the recommended plan set forth in the joint report submitted to the congress November 28, 1951, by the secretaries of commerce and interior pursuant to the act of August 24, 1949 (P. L. 262, 81st congress) to the end that the highway commission shall have authority to act with reference to them as provided by this section.
