## CHAPTER 276

- AN ACT to amend 16.08 (2) (d); and to create 41.72 (4) of the statutes, relating to removing teachers in the Wisconsin school for the deaf from the classified service.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
  - SECTION 1. 16.08 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 16.08 (2) (d) All presidents, deans, principals, professors, instructors, research assistants, librarians and other teachers, as defined in s. 42.20, in the university, state teachers colleges \* \* \* and the Wisconsin school for the deaf.
  - SECTION 2. 41.72 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
- 41.72 (4) The state superintendent of public instruction shall employ the teachers at the Wisconsin school for the deaf and determine their compensation, in the manner provided in ss. 40.40 and 40.41.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1955.
