CHAPTER 30

AN ACT to create 57.14 of the statutes, relating to co-operative return of parole and probation violators.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

57.14 of the statutes is created to read:

57.14 CO-OPERATIVE RETURN OF PAROLE AND PROBATION VIOLATORS. The director of the state department of public welfare is authorized and empowered to deputize any person regularly employed by another state to act as an officer and agent of this state in effecting the return of any person who has violated the terms and conditions of parole or probation as granted by this state. In any matter relating to the return of such person, any agent so deputized shall have all the powers of a police officer of this state. Any deputization pursuant to this statute shall be in writing and any person authorized to act as an agent of this state pursuant hereto shall carry formal evidence of his deputization and shall produce the same upon demand.
