## CHAPTER 370

AN ACT to create 85.54 (4) of the statutes, relating to weight tolerances for vehicles transporting unmanufactured forest products.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.54 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

85.54 (4) Unmanufactured forest products; Weight tolerances. For enforcement purposes only and to provide for practical operating problems and tolerances of every nature in the application of s. 85.47 (1) (a) to 2-axle motor trucks transporting unmanufactured forest products, only no summons or complaint shall be issued, served or enforced under said par. (a) unless the gross weight imposed on the highway by the wheels on any one axle of a vehicle shall exceed 21,000 pounds and in no case shall the gross weight upon any one wheel of such vehicle, or multiple wheels, supporting one end of an axle and resting on the roadway exceed 11,000 pounds.
