CHAPTER 409

AN ACT to amend 85.05 (5) of the statutes, relating to interchange of trailers and semitrailers and reciprocal agreements with other states made by the commissioner of the motor vehicle department.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

85.05 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

85.05 (5) Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this section, the commissioner of the motor vehicle department, with the approval of the governor, shall have authority to enter into reciprocal agreements with the responsible officers of other states as to licenses, permit fees, mileage and flat taxes under which motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers properly licensed or registered in other states may be operated in interstate commerce in this state without a Wisconsin registration or the payment of permit fees or mileage or flat taxes, provided like privileges are accorded to vehicles owned by Wisconsin residents when operated in such other states, provided further, that trailers and semitrailers owned by residents of a state with which a reciprocal agreement is in effect pursuant to this chapter may be operated in * * * commerce by a Wisconsin resident in Wisconsin without the payment of fees or ton mile or flat taxes when such trailers or semitrailers are operated in exchange for trailers or semitrailers or are operated in accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the commissioner of the motor vehicle department respecting the interchange of equipment.
