CHAPTER 555

AN ACT to amend 41.16 (2) of the statutes, relating to tax levied for special schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

41.16 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

41.16 (2) The municipality shall levy and collect and the clerk shall spread on the roll a tax, which together with the other funds provided for the same purpose, shall be equal to the amount so required by said local board, but such tax shall not exceed 2 mills on the dollar, except that when such tax shall not produce sufficient revenue the municipality may by ordinance provide that such tax shall not exceed 2 mills on the last equalized valuation of the taxable property in the municipality.
