CHAPTER 595

AN ACT to create 36.16 (1) (ac) and (ad) of the statutes, relating to resident status at the university for tuition purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

36.16 (1) (ac) and (ad) of the statutes are created to read:

36.16 (1) (ac) Notwithstanding the provisions of par. (b), any female student who attended the university as a minor student exempt from the fees for nonresident tuition, and who would continue to be entitled to the exemptions provided in par. (a) except for having married a non-resident, shall continue to be entitled to such exemptions.

(ad) Notwithstanding the provisions of par. (b), any female student who entered the university as a nonresident student and married a resident student after matriculation, shall be entitled to the exemptions provided in par. (a) after attending the university for 2 full consecutive semesters as a nonresident, and while continuing to reside in this state.
