CHAPTER 606

AN ACT to amend 20.60 (3); and to create 93.09 (10) of the statutes, relating to the collection of fees in the grading of food and farm products, and providing for a revolving appropriation of \$7,500 annually.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.60 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.60 (3) As a revolving appropriation all moneys received for or on account of any requested accounting or audit service under ss. 93.06

(6) (b), 100.06 (1) (c) and 100.07, and any grading or supervisory service under s. 93.09 (10), or any requested services in the inspection of food or farm products and facilities used in the production or processing thereof, for conducting such requested services. The department shall annually determine rates sufficient to defray the costs of such services.

SECTION 2. 93.09 (10) of the statutes is created to read:

93.09 (10) Whenever any standard is established under this section the department, by regulation, may require any person marketing products or receptacles to which such standard is applicable to secure a permit and pay uniform fees to the department sufficient to cover the cost of the supervision of the grading and inspection provided for in the standard.
