CHAPTER 627

AN ACT to create 20.005 (1) (b) (line 359y) of the statutes and to appropriate the sum of \$56.10 to G. J. Zimmerman of West Allis, Wisconsin to compensate him for damages sustained to his 1950 Chevrolet automobile as the result of being struck from the rear on August 1, 1954, at the intersection of state trunk highway 57 and Capital Drive in the city of West Allis, Wisconsin by a motor vehicle of the Wisconsin national guard then and there being negligently operated by an officer of the Wisconsin national guard.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (1) (b) (line 359y) of the statutes is created to read:

20.005 (1) (b) 359y. G. J. Zimmerman \$56.10

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the general fund \$56.10 to G. J. Zimmerman of 1000 South 109th Street, West Allis, Wisconsin, to compensate him for damages sustained to his 1950 Chevrolet automobile as the result of being struck from the rear on August 1, 1954, at the intersection of state trunk highway 57 and Capital Drive in the city of West Allis, Wisconsin, by a motor vehicle of the Wisconsin national guard then and there being negligently operated by an officer of the Wisconsin national guard. Acceptance of this appropriation by G. J. Zimmerman shall operate as a full and complete discharge of the state of Wisconsin from all liability for damages resulting from said automobile accident.
