CHAPTER 631

AN ACT to amend section 2 of chapter 567, laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 28, laws of 1913; and to create section 2m of chapter 567, laws of 1911, relating to Camp Randall memorial park.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 567, laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 28, laws of 1913, is amended to read:

(Chapter 567, laws of 1911) Section 2. It shall be the duty of, and said commission is authorized to set aside a portion of Camp Randall to be used as a memorial park. Such park shall include a portion of Camp Randall described as follows: Commencing on the west line of * * * Randall avenue 96.6 feet north of the center line of Dayton street produced; thence west at right angles to * * * Randall avenue 462 feet; thence south 812.1 feet to the north line of Monroe street; thence north 50 degrees 14 minutes along the north line of Monroe street 601 feet to the west line of * * * Randall avenue; thence north along the west line of * * * Randall avenue 429 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.58 acres. The use of such park for military drill and athletic purposes shall be allowed to the university.

SECTION 2. Section 2m of chapter 567, laws of 1911, is created to read:

(Chapter 567, laws of 1911) Section 2m. No structures other than the Camp Randall memorial building project now in progress shall be placed or erected upon said Camp Randall memorial park unless authorized by the legislature; nor shall said park be used for any purpose other than authorized herein; and in the event the present Camp Randall memorial building is removed, that part of the premises on which said building is located (as described herein) shall be restored to park use.
