CHAPTER 65

AN ACT to repeal chapter 185, laws of 1951, relating to abolishing the municipal court for the city of Sheboygan in the event a municipal court for Sheboygan county is established and transferring its records, files, papers and unfinished business to said municipal court of Sheboygan county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

In the event chapter 64 (Bill No. 345 S., 1955), laws of 1955, becomes law, chapter 185, laws of 1951, shall, effective on the first Monday in June 1956, be repealed and the municipal court of the city of Sheboygan abolished, and on that day all actions, proceedings, orders, judgments, determinations, records, files, papers and documents of the municipal court of the city of Sheboygan shall be transferred to and continue as such in the municipal court for Sheboygan county, and any unfinished business in the municipal court for the city of Sheboygan shall be completed in the municipal court for Sheboygan county as though commenced therein or if the provisions of said chapter 64 (Bill No. 345, S.) are insufficient for the purpose, then it shall be completed in the municipal court for Sheboygan county under the law as it existed prior to such transfer.
