CHAPTER 495

AN ACT to amend 97.047 of the statutes, relating to bulk purchase of milk for private consumption.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 97.047 of the statutes is amended to read:

97.047 Effective July 1, 1957, all milk and fluid milk products sold for consumption in fluid form shall be produced, processed and distributed in accordance with definitions and standards for Grade A milk and milk products as set forth in the milk ordinance and code, 1953 recommendations of the public health service, U.S. department of health, welfare and education, publication No. 229, except that the requirements for bottling and sterilization of bottles in such standards shall not apply to milk sold by a producer, selling only milk produced by him on his own farm under his own supervision, and selling such milk only in his own milk house, which milk meets the requirements of Grade A standards as set forth by the state department of agriculture, to a purchaser who has provided his own container, which has been sanitized in a manner comparable to the sanitizing of the utensils used in the production of said milk by said producer, if said purchaser is purchasing said milk for his own consumption.

SECTION 2. If this bill and Bill No. 471, A., are both enacted the revisor is directed to give full effect to this bill.
