## CHAPTER 630

AN ACT to amend 129.02 (2) of the statutes, relating to issuance of peddler's licenses to disabled persons without fee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

129.02 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

129.02 (2) Any ex-soldier of the United States in any war, who has a twenty-five per cent disability or more or has a cardiac disability recognized by the United States veterans \* \* \* administration, and any person disabled to the extent of the loss of one arm or one leg or more or who has been declared blind under s. 49.18 (4), shall upon presenting proof to the department that he satisfies these conditions, be granted a special license without payment of any fee. Such \* \* \* person must have been a bona fide resident of this state for at least 5 years preceding the application, and shall while engaged in such business carry on his person his license and the proof required for its issuance, and such blind person shall also carry a picture of himself which is not more than 3 years old. Such special license shall not entitle a blind person to peddle for hire for another person.
