## CHAPTER 685

AN ACT to amend 92.08 (3) and (10) of the statutes, relating to the procedure for acquiring property or rights or interests therein by soil conservation districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

92.08 (3) and (10) of the statutes are amended to read:

92.08 (3) To obtain options upon and to acquire, by purchase, exchange, lease, gift, grant, bequest, devise or otherwise any property, real or personal, or rights or interests therein or in water; to acquire by eminent domain proceedings under ch. 32 any property or right or interests therein for watershed protection and flood prevention works of improve-

ment which will be installed as a part of a watershed plan under P. L. 566, 83rd congress, as amended or supplemented by the 84th congress and the first session of the 85th congress; to maintain, administer and improve any properties acquired, to receive income from such properties and to expend such income in carrying out the purposes and provisions of this chapter; and to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of any of its property or interests therein in furtherance of the purposes and the provisions of this chapter.

(10) No provisions with respect to the acquisition, operation or disposition of property by other public bodies shall be applicable to a district organized hereunder \* \* \* except as provided in sub. (3).
