## CHAPTER 122

AN ACT to amend 23.09 (6); and to create 29.174 (4a) of the statutes, relating to emergency rules of the conservation commission.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 23.09 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

23.09 (6) The commission shall employ a conservation director who shall continue in office at the pleasure of the commission. Said director shall be a person having executive ability and experience, special training and skill in conservation work, and shall not \* \* \* come under the classified service. He shall be administrative head of the state conservation department, shall be responsible to the commission for the execution of its policies; shall employ, by and with the advice and consent of the commission, such technical and administrative assistance as may be necessary for the execution of such policies, and shall exercise the powers of the commission in the interim of its meetings but subordinate thereto, but shall not have authority to make rules and regulations other than emergency rules adopted pursuant to s. 227.027.

SECTION 2. 29.174 (4a) of the statutes is created to read:

29.174 (4a) The conservation director is authorized to make emergency rules pursuant to s. 227.027.
