- 255.04 (2) (c) The commissioners shall also furnish upon periodic request of the sheriff a current list of the names of persons available for jury duty in justice of the peace court, mental inquiries and reexaminations, coroner's inquests, and for such other purposes as the sheriff is required by law to summon or select a jury, which list shall contain not less than 100 nor more than 200 names of persons drawn and apportioned in the manner provided in par. (a).
