## CHAPTER 170

AN ACT to amend 1.10 of the statutes, relating to the Wisconsin state song.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1.10 of the statutes is amended to read:

1.10 STATE SONG, TREE, FLOWER, BIRD, FISH, ANIMAL AND WILD LIFE ANIMAL. The Wisconsin state song is "On, Wisconsin", music written by W. T. Purdy, the words to which are as follows: "On, Wisconsin! On, Wisconsin! Grand old badger state! We, thy loyal sons and daughters, Hail thee, good and great. On, Wisconsin! On, Wisconsin! Champion of the right, Forward', our motto — God will give thee might!"; the Wisconsin state tree is the sugar maple (acer saccharum); the Wisconsin state bird is the robin (turdus migratorius); the Wisconsin state fish is the muskellunge (Esox masquinongy masquinongy Mitchell); the Wisconsin state animal is the badger (taxidea taxus) and the Wisconsin wild life animal is the white-tailed deer (odocoileus virginianus). The Wisconsin Blue Book shall include the information contained in this section concerning the state song, tree, flower, bird, fish, animal and wild life animal.
