CHAPTER 183

- AN ACT to amend 343.01 (2) (e) 2 and 343.12 (1) of the statutes, relating to the licensing of operators of a school bus transporting pupils or school groups to or from a private school.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - SECTION 1. 343.01 (2) (e) 2 of the statutes is amended to read:
- 343.01 (2) (e) 2. He is engaged in operating or employed for the principal purpose of operating a school bus, or a motor bus transporting children or school groups to or from a private school or to or from points designated by such private school; or
 - SECTION 2. 343.12 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 343.12 (1) No person shall operate a school bus, or a motor bus transporting children or school groups to or from a private school or to or from points designated by such private school, without having first applied for and received a school bus operator's license.
