## **CHAPTER 189**

- AN ACT to create 274.11 (4) of the statutes, relating to the supreme court's period of jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties in an action on appeal.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
  - 274.11 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
- 274.11 (4) The right of appeal shall exist from the time of the entry of the appealable order or judgment and in cases of appeal the supreme court shall have jurisdiction over the subject matter of the action from that time. The procedural requirements of subs. (1), (2) and (3) and of this chapter shall relate only to the jurisdiction of the court over the parties to the appeal.
